




2025 Meat Canning Report: 18,360 pounds of chicken thigh meat was used resulting in 11,230 cans of meat as well as about 320 pounds of raw meat shared with Milford Food Net and 320 pounds with the Lincoln Peoples City Mission. The price of the chicken meat was expected to be around \$1.90 but ended up costing \$1.32 per pound. A "per can fee" of \$1.50 is also paid to help with the canner expenses as well as to pay for shipping the canned meat to destinations around the world to people in need. We began with a balance of \$11, 453.50, thanks to 2024 donations even though we didn't can. With 2025 donations of \$\$30,681 and expenses of \$38,718.22, we ended the season with a positive balance \$3416.28. Thank you for your donations of time and money.
