WDC ANNUAL ASSEMBLY! It's not just for church leaders! It's for everybody! August 11-13, 2023 at Tabor Mennonite Church, Newton, KS, we'll worship, work, eat great, local food, enjoy local music, connect with new and old friends, experience faith formation for all ages, and have many choices of great workshops. It's a great place to learn about and grow in faith in Christ, care for the broader church, and worship our God of love and justice with God's people in WDC!

**Assembly Theme:** We will explore listening to God and to each other through our theme, "**Holy (Wholly) Listening.**" We will stretch ourselves to listen carefully to one another as siblings in Christ who understand scripture differently and can widen our cultural, racial, and identity perspectives as we focus on faith in Christ together.
