Ervin R. Stutzman, 72, Mennonite Church USA's second executive director (2010-2018), died on June 3, 2025. Stutzman was known as a talented leader, teacher and preacher, who was deeply committed to Christ and the church. He was instrumental in the formation of the denomination as part of the executive board in the merger of the Mennonite Church and General Conference Mennonite Church. He served as moderator-elect from 1999 to 2001 and as the first moderator of the newly formed Mennonite Church USA from 2001 to 2003. He is survived by his wife, Bonita, and children Emma Dawson and Benjamin Stutzman and their families; and his twin Erma Mae Yoder, Pennsylvania. His memorial service was June 8 at Park View Mennonite Church, Harrisonburg, VA, Memorials may be sent to the MC USA Archives, MC USA, 718 N. Main St., Newton, KS 67114.
